# DISCOVERY TOUR

## OVERVIEW

By visiting three stations, students will learn how each part of the farm strives to work in harmony with one another and nature.

## EDUCATION GARDEN

- Hear farmers share the "farm-to-table" process, from seed to harvest, with topics of nurturing soil and seasonal crops.
- See and learn how our busy bees help pollinate, how worms and microbes help compost, to support a full circle food production.



## ANIMAL HABITATS

- Interact with a range of animals on the farm, from alpacas, rabbits, guinea pigs, to Muscovy ducks, roosters, turtles and more!
- Discover how animals benefit our farm ecosystem, and see farmers work to maintain their habitats.
